



Old House Road

Supported Housing Scheme

Supported housing is accommodation for people who are aged 60 and over, who can live on their own but who would like to have support close by.

We have 33 supported housing schemes across Dacorum with a range of self-contained flats and bungalows. Social gatherings and activities are often available within these schemes.

Old House Road in Adeyfield, Hemel Hempstead, is a purpose built supported scheme.

Where is Old House Road?

Old House Road Supported Housing Scheme is in Adeyfield in Hemel Hempstead, the scheme is a short walk to Queens Square where there are shops and the community centre.

The nearest doctors' surgery is Everest House Surgery, which is less than 5 minutes' walk away.

How many flats are there?

There are 63 properties in the scheme, some are flats in blocks and some bungalows with individual gardens.

What facilities are there?

There is a communal lounge and a laundry for tenants to use. The scheme also has plenty of green space around the blocks of flats.

What activities do other tenants participate in?

This scheme has regular groups that meet to play bingo, knit and natter. The tenants are a welcoming community who organise events such as fish and chip suppers and Christmas parties. We also run tablet courses to help tenants get online as part of our **Tenant Academy**, and a range of other free courses are available.
